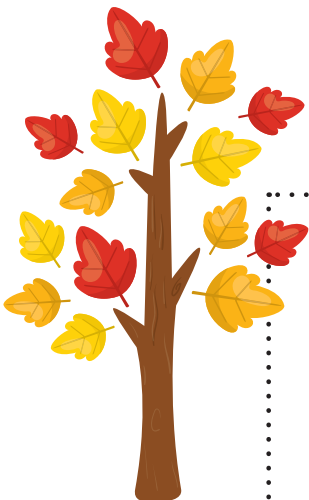

Kids Cheat Sheet:

ADJECTIVE: DESCRIBES WHAT THE NOUN LOOKS, SMELLS, SOUNDS, FEELS OR TASTES LIKE.

EX: AGREEABLE, ELEGANT, FANCY, BEAUTIFUL, GRUMPY, HUGE, BIG, OLD, ROUND, YELLOW.

NOUN: A NOUN IS THE NAME OF A PERSON, PLACE OR THING.

EX: GIRL, SCHOOL, BEE, BOOK

PROPER-NOUN: THIS IS USED FOR A PARTICULAR PERSON, PLACE, OR THING.

EX: SALLY, KANSAS, SATURDAY

VERB: A VERB IS SOMETHING YOU DO. IT DESCRIBES WHAT ACTION SOMEONE OR SOMETHING IS DOING.

EX: RUN, JUMPED, SWAM, SLEEP, CLEAN, READ, COOK, PAINT.

PLURAL-NOUN: PLURAL MEANS MORE THAN ONE. SO A PLURAL-NOUN IS MORE THAN ONE PERSON, PLACE OR THING.

EX: BIRDS, BROOMS, FLOWERS, DESKS, SISTERS.

ADVERB: THIS IS A WORD THAT DESCRIBES A VERB, ADJECTIVE OR ANOTHER ADVERB. IT TELLS US HOW, HOW OFTEN, WHEN, AND WHERE.

EX: HAPPILY, LOUDLY, ALWAYS, NEVER, TWICE, AFTER, BEFORE, HOME, OUTSIDE, SADLY OFTEN, NOW, NEAR.
